CHRISTIAN G. AND DOROTHEA W. HEESS

AND THEIR DESCENDANTS

1852 - 1955

Christian G. and Dorothea W. Heess emigrated to America in the year 1852. They came from Connatadt, near Stutgart, in the Kingdom of Wurtemburg, Germany. They came to this country, in part at least, to escape the military conscription, under which all the young men in Germany were forced to serve several years in the army. Christian G. Heess was a cabinet maker by trade. In preparation for coming to this country, he made several large boxes or trunks, in which they packed all their belongings and in 1852 they embarked on a sailing vessel from the port of Havre, France. They were on the ocean several weeks or perhaps one month.

They landed at New York, and intended going to the industrial city of Cleveland, Ohio. They had friends there and they expected to find employment for the older boys.

However, in New York they fell into the hands of a man by name of Smith. He posed as a land specialist and painted a very rosy picture of a place at Elk Lake, Elkland Township, Sullivan County, Pa. They bargained for a parcel of land at this place but on arrival they found it to be mostly forest, the soil very thin and poor and nothing but a sort of shed or stable to live in. They remained there at least three years as there twin sons, Robert and Paul, were born in this stable. In 1856 after going through all this privation and hardship, it turned out that Smith could not give them a clear title to the land and they lost it and also their money.

At the end of this period they purchased about 100 acres of virgin forest at a place about five miles distant, but still in Elkland Township. On this they built a large log house, a barn and other small buildings. Some years later they built a very comfortable large frame house. By very hard work, much privation and many hardships, they firally made for themselves a very good home and a productive farm.

With very few roads, few bridges and an all day journey to any town to do trading, these were the pioneer days in Sullivan County. They brought with them from Germany four sons, Carl age 4, Theodore age 7, Albert and Ferdinand, whose ages were probably about 9 and 14. Also two daughters, Matilda, age 1 and Amelia, age 11. The older grandchildren, Albert F. Heess have only a dim recollection of their grandfather, but remember very well their grandmother. They went often across the fields to see her and she always had a nice lunch of sweets ready. She kept her hardwood floors scrubbed white. They can also see her now, as she sat reading her German Bible.

Grandfather had a shop in the log house and he made fine furniture of cherry wood. Some of this is still in use by his grandchildren.

Christian G. Heess was born in 1808 and died in 1877. Dorothea W. Heess was born in 1817 and died in 1882.

They were borh buried in Friends Old Burying Ground at Shunk, Fox Township, Sullivan County, Pa.

Christian G. and Dorothea W. Heess and their children were in this country only eight years when the War of the Rebellion (Civil War) broke out and the two sons Albert and Ferdinand volunteered in the Union Army.

- (III) Albert Heess. Born in Germany, probably about 1843 was killed while serving in the Union Army. Date not known. His Commander asked for volunteers to carry out a dangerous mission, to find a Confederate soldier who was shooting our men. Albert and two other soldiers volunteered. The two other men returned but Albert did not, and probably was killed by the Confederate soldier. Reliable information informed his people that he was lost and probably killed at the time of the Second Battle of Bull Run.
 - (I) Ferdinand Heess. Born in Germany, probably about 1838. He was taken with some disease while serving in the Union Army and died in an Army Hospital in the South. His body was brought home and was buried in Friends Old Burying Ground at Shunk, Fox Township, Sullivan County, Pa. His grave is marked by the regulation marker furnished by the United States Government, on which is his name and military rank, Co K-50 Pa.
 - (II) Amelia Heess. Second child of Christian G. and Dorothea W. Heess. Born in Germany and came to this country with her parents when she was 11 years of age. She was born June 6, 1841 and died June 1, 1926. For a number of years she kept house and raised the family for a prosperous farmer by name of Joshua Battin. His farm joined that of Amelia's father, Christian G. Heess. After her mothers death she went back home and kept house for her brother Paul.

When her brother Paul left the farm and went to Williamsport, she married Joshua Battin and they moved into a new house which he had built on his farm. Later she was widowed, but she remained at this home until she died. They were both buried in Friends Burying Ground at Elkland Township, Sullivan County, Pa.

(IV) Theodore Christian Heess. Fourth child of Christian G. and Dorothea W. Heess. Born in Germany, February 4, 1845. Died at Elkland, Sullivan County, Pa., Oct. 6, 1916. He purchased a piece of heavily timbered land adjoining his fathers farm. By very hard work and good management he developed one of the best

farms in that section. In addition to the farm work he had a power feed mill and did his grinding of feed for the livestock. He also did grinding for some of his neighbors. He had a blacksmith shop and did his own horse shoeing and other repair work. He married Elizabeth McCarty March 29, 1871. She was born August 16, 1844 and died March 14, 1937. She was the daughter of Aaron and Elizabeth (Pardoe) McCarty. Her grandparents were Joel and Ellen (Roberts) McCarty. They were among the first settlers of Sullivan County, Pa. Ellen was a minister in Friends Society. They raised a family of eleven children. For a more complete record of the McCarty families see the book entitled: "The Descendants of James Carrell and Sarah Dungan". See also "Brief History of The McCarty Families Who Settled In Sullivan County, Pa."

The children of Theodore C. and Elizabeth M. Heess wish to pay tribute to their parents whose exemplary lives and habits of industry has been of so much value to them as they have in some measure tried to follow in their footsteps. They were buried in Friends Burying Ground in Elkland, Sullivan County, Pa.

Theodore C. Heess was in robust health at the time of his death at age 71. His death was accidental in a fall from an apple tree. His wife, Elizabeth enjoyed good health until she died at age 92. They were both consistant members of the Society of Friends.

He taught at Friends School and the public schools of Sullivan County and a public school at Tyrone, Pa. In 1903 he entered the law office of Rush J. Thompson of Duehore, Pa. where he remained until December 1907. In 1907 he was elected Prothonotary, Register of Wills and Clerk of the Courts of Sullivan County. He held this office for six terms or until January 1932, at which time he was appointed to fill the unexpired term of District Attorney of Sullivan County. He was later twice elected to this office, the last time in 1944 at the age of seventy-eight. He practiced law in Sullivan County until September 1955 when he and his wife Elizabeth went to live with their son Robert H. Heess at Avondale. Pa., where he now resides.

Albert Ferdinand Heess was the first grandchild born to Christian G. and Dorothea W. Heess and he was given the names of his two uncles, Albert and Ferdinand, who gave their lives for their country while serving in the Union Army during the Civil War.

Married Elizabeth M. Rogers, youngest daughter and thirteenth child of Johnathan and Elizabeth Rogers of Lincoln Falls, Sullivan County, Pa. She was born February 26, 1869. Teacher in Public Schools of Sullivan County. Died at the home of their son Robert H. Heess, Avondale, Pa., June 18, 1955. Buried in Friends Cemetery, Elkland Township, Sullivan County, Pa.
