Dear Ernest,

I received your letter today and was glad to hear from you once again, for I was wondering how you was and where you was so I will answer right this evening and get it in the mail tomorrow so that you will get it soon before you go some where else there isn't much news around here as there are only a few family's living around here and Ernie, you asked about the Murray Place they sold it to a fellow from New Jersey his name is Albert Braun and he is just going to use it for skeek ends in the summer time and for hunting season the well went dry so he don't have any water up at the house. Well we had another dry summer here this summer and the crops were not to good. I have the Barn here at home full of hay and straw so that will have to do me for the winter.

I have 2 horses and 6 head of cattle and  
 & 6 sheep to winter not as much stock as  
 I had last winter, the sheep had 30  
 lambs last spring and I lost five  
 so I had twenty five lambs to raise  
 I sold all of them but one and I  
 sold seven head of sheep. I had 3 fresh  
 cows last spring and I sold all  
 the calves for feed and sold one cow  
 and the bull well you asked about  
 the saw mill it is still running  
 and I guess they have timber enough  
 yet to last nearly a year or until  
 next spring my how far I worked  
 for them nearly all summer in the  
 Woods I just took time enough to make  
 the hay. I had a couple boys to help  
 me with the hay as we made it in  
 a hurry I dole nearly all of the farming  
 with the tractor this summer so we  
 didn't lose much time I had 5 acre  
 of oats planted and got 16-4 bushel  
 I cut it with the binder on a Monday  
 and threshed it on Tuesday I did not  
 shock it just threw it on the

Wagon and hauled it to the Barn and  
 run it through the threshing machine  
 I Planted Corn 2 times this Spring and  
 The Black Birds Pulled it Both times  
 so I dont have any Corn or Curr stalks to  
 feed to the cattle - No I didn't get started  
 to Build the new house yet. as I worked  
 in the woods to steady and didn't have  
 much time to work around home. I  
 have the lumber all sawed to Build  
 it with, well I have my work pretty  
 Well Caught up now but to dig the  
 Potatoes and do some fall Planting and  
 haul out some Manure yes we had  
 5 or 6 heavy frosts for the last two weeks  
 that killed every thing. It was so dry here all  
 Summer that the Pasture was Poor and the  
 Cows didn't give much milk I am putting a  
 electric fence around a couple fields so  
 I can pasture them for a while before  
 the Snow comes yes old man winter  
 soon be here again. It just seems like  
 we didn't have much of a Summer well  
 I was kept to busy to enjoy the summer

Working in the Woods and doing the farm work. I sure Put in long days I didn't get to see Helena all Summer the last that I saw her was in March, she was up in Canada most of the summer taking treatments for her Blood from a Doctor in Canada she is Back home now she wrote and said she was some better but could not do much work I must go up to Endicott some week end and see her for I was married about her all Summer. I hope that I will find her in real good health.

Well you asked how many People left since I wrote. Arthur McDonald died last Spring and Johnnie Sick died last week, and Sara McDonald died last week up in Elmira she was a sister to Willie and Jamie McDonald.

Well we don't have any apples at all this year the frost killed all of the blossoms this spring.

You asked about the fish in the Pond No the hard winter didn't hurt them there is a lot of nice fish in the

Pond Charley Fitzpatrick come out here a couple weeks ago and caught 25 nice Big Bullheads. I didn't do much fishing my self this summer as I was working to long of days, and when night come I was tired so I would go to Bed so I would get some rest.

Charley and his wife and Elsie and her husband was here to see me this evening, Charley and Sara always are aful good to me and I always like to see them come.

Well Ernest at the present time I have an aful bad cold. I didn't walk yesterday or today I just done the chores and built a little fence and stayed in the house most of the time I was out to the Doctors last Friday and again yesterday the cold is in my head and throat and I feel weak all over. Well I just am not to strong now for I walked so hard this summer that I lost 10 pounds I only

Weigh 130 Pounds and I should weigh 140  
 So you see I am not very Big I never  
 Was as Big as the rest of you Boys I was  
 always the runt, even the man that I am  
 Working for tells me that I am working  
 to hard and Putting in to long of hours  
 Well I Guess I will do Better after I get  
 a good Cook if every thing goes all right  
 she should come sometime this winter  
 No she is not a Widow she is a single  
 Girl. And a good Cook

Well Ernest you say that you don't  
 have no Job or don't know if you  
 can get a Job or a Place to stay  
 and that there is nothing out there for  
 you any more. Well if you don't have  
 no Job or no Place to stay why don't you  
 come back to Penna I still have Beds  
 in the house and there is always some  
 thing here to eat and there is lots of wood  
 to keep the house warm and I have two  
 good stoves that keep the house warm so  
 don't stay out there in the cold and freeze  
 well I will close now no take care of yourself and  
 write again soon I remain as always Bro. Peter
